The renowned Little House Books, cherished by children around the world were penned in this white farmhouse on Rocky Ridge Farm.

Laura Ingalls Wilder and her family were attracted to the culture and climate of the Ozarks in 1895. Wilder Days celebrates that culture today in the hospitality of a small community, the vitality of Ozarks style music, and a safe, family atmosphere.
